- 6. Electronic bids must be submitted to the office **Supreme Court of Nepal, Ramshah Path, Kathmandu through PPMO's e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp** on or before **12:00 PM on 2080/10/15.** Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
- 7. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 13:00 PM on 2080/10/15 the office of Supreme Court of Nepal. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of NRs. 4,00,000.00, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
